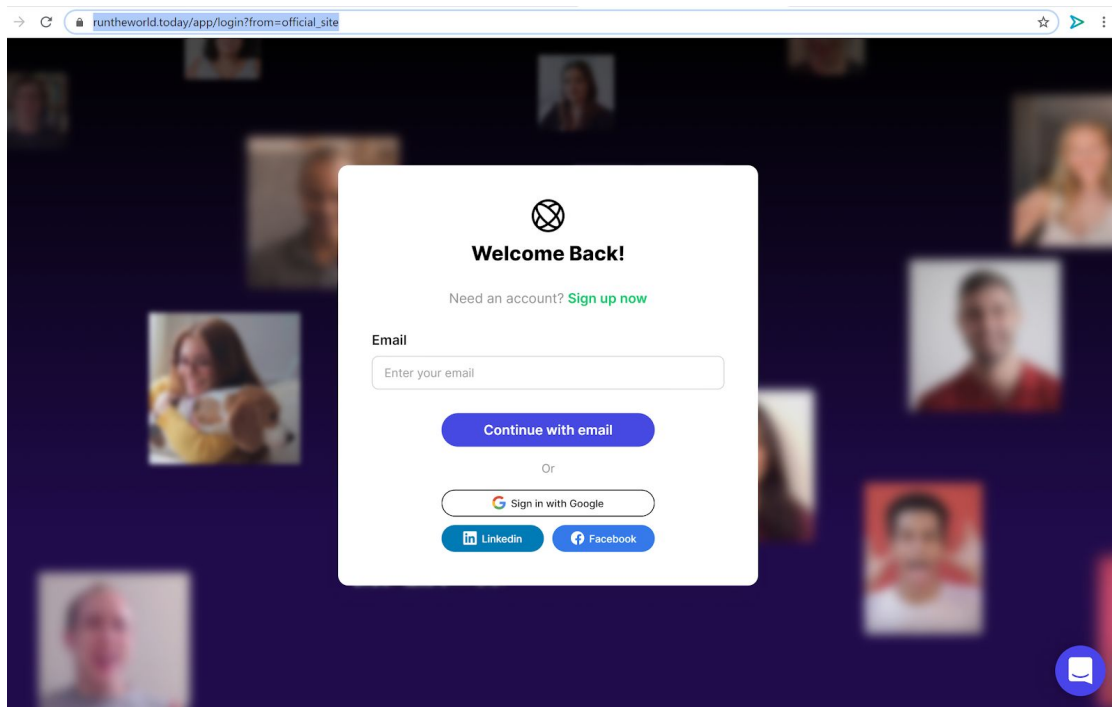


Creating Communities 2020: Joining instructions for *Run the World*

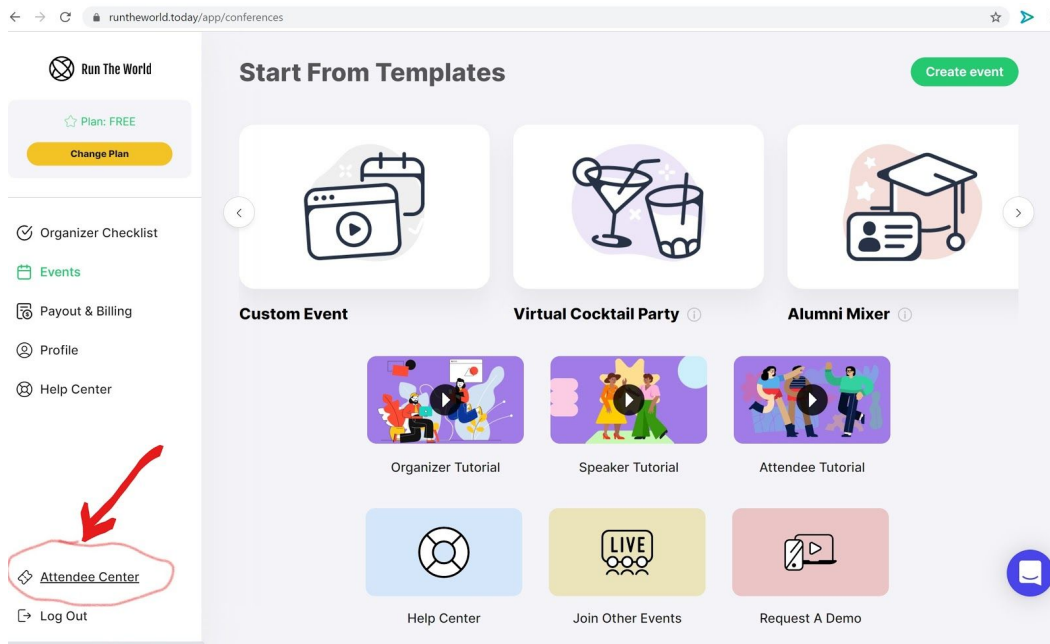
Prior to joining:

- Tune in through the Run the World events app! Available on all app stores, it will allow you to dip in and out of each session, get notifications when they are due to start, and network with other attendees.

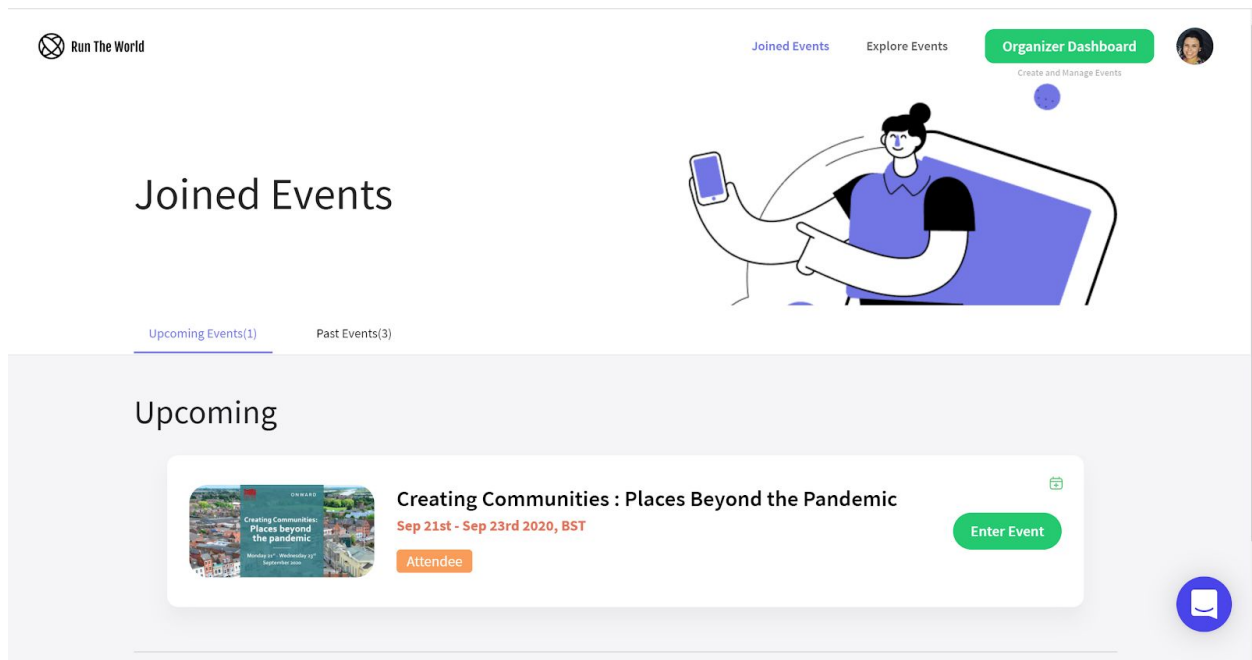
1. Please login to *Run the World* by clicking [here](#) using the details you submitted to register for the event.




2. Once you have successfully logged in, you will see the below homepage. Click on 'Attendee centre'
